How much does it cost to register for a PJammin® for Kids with Cancer event?

Nothing! ACCO covers the cost of all the materials and shipping. We want to support your efforts in raising awareness of childhood cancer. We simply ask that you promote your event in advance to bring your school community together for this great cause!

What materials will I receive?

You will receive a customized digital flyer, a social media guide for promotion, complimentary swag items (your choice of stickers, tattoos, or silicone bracelets), and an Early Warning Signs poster for your school clinic.

When will I receive my materials?

If you have pre-registered far in advance, a representative from ACCO will contact you a month before your event to confirm your event date and delivery address. If you registered at least 3 weeks before your event, you will receive your materials at least a week before your PJammin® Day.

What if I need to change my event date?

ACCO can accommodate changes made to an event registration date up to three weeks prior and cannot guarantee that all materials will arrive on time if less notification is given.

What percent of my donations go to supporting families of childhood cancer?



GOAL SETTING You will be assisted with creating a challenging and attainable goal for your awareness event. The size and involvement level of your school will be considered to ensure you have a successful event.



MATERIALS The amounts of prizes, envelopes, etc. are based on the numbers you provide during registration. We can help you with a plan on how to successfully use your materials. If at any point you decide you need more or would like to structure your event differently, most adjustments can be made a week out from your event.



FLYERS Custom digital flyers can be created for your event. These flyers can be hung up at the front office, in the classroom and around other high volume areas for all to see. The flyer will be sent to you in a PDF for personal printing.



VIDEO CHAT Students have many tricky questions about tough issues, like cancer. A representative from ACCO can set up a video chat with your class to share information about childhood cancer and answer the tough questions for you. Technical capabilities are through Skype, Google Hangout, and GoToMeeting.

Academic Standards Inferencing is a skill that all students

need! A 25-minute animated cartoon that we give to children diagnosed with cancer can be provided. In the video, a child with cancer is seen as a hero who battles the evil cancer-dragon with the help of medications and family support. There are NO words in this video, so students will have to make several inferences to understand the storyline. Teacher and student guides are available to go along with this video as well.
