

Each year in the United States, approximately **15,780** children are diagnosed with cancer before the age of 19.



83.5% of families with a child with cancer will experience some level of financial hardship.



75.7% of families with a child with cancer will have at least one parent who needs to cut back on work or stop working all together.



67.3% of families with a child with cancer have health insurance through the parent's employer. This is either canceled or changed if the parent has to quit their job.



11.9% of families with a child with cancer will spend more than \$10,000 annually to care for their child.
