ex. carefully, gently, extremely

PREPOSITION: WORDS THAT HELP MODIFY OTHER WORDS

ex. by, with, about, until

CONJUNCTION: JOINS WORDS OR PHRASES

ex. and, but, or, while, because

INTERJECTION: WORDS THAT EXPRESS EMOTION!

ex. Wow!, Oops!,, Oh!
